
Exhibitors' Representatives' Report

This month the artists have been busy working towards our August "Artists of the Month" exhibition in the gallery, There will be a variety of work and information to promote new members to join the Group. 15 artists worked on an original artwork plus a small 7" x 5" artwork as a group display. Art cards will also be available for purchase. Unfortunately this exhibition will be disrupted when the Gallery is closed for some repainting.



Renown Clarence Valley artist Julianne Gosper certainly created much interest and admiration with her information, exhibits and demonstrations in Ferry Park foyer on the 9th July. Titled "A walk on the wild side" she featured her wild life beautiful artworks of animals and birds. Julianne gave step by step demonstrations of the process involved in mixed media artworks with a range of water based mediums, surfaces and colour mixing exercises. The group is considering a workshop with Julianne.

Sunday 4th August 11am to 12noon Stephen Cassettari will attend Ferry Park foyer with his Chinese Painting Demonstration. Stephen is a full-time artist, writer and teacher of Chinese brush painting. He has written over 10 books on aspects of the techniques of Chinese Painting. 6 to 10 paintings will be produced at the demonstration with explanations on technique, philosophy and history of the ancient art of one stroke. Books cards and bamboo brushes will be available to purchase.
