Bec Davies (Just Add Salt):

I'm a graphic and web designer by trade, but my creative journey has led me to the world of ceramics. A lifelong maker, I rediscovered clay eight years ago through a local course, and I've been hooked ever since. My practice has grown to include hand-building, slip-casting, and, most recently, wheel throwing, which has become my main method of making.

In January 2024, I began a 30-day daily throwing challenge, and it completely shifted my approach. Since then, I've been working consistently at the wheel, developing my style and refining my techniques. I work from my home studio, located not far from Ferry Park Gallery, where I spend my spare time making.

All my ceramics are functional and food-safe. You'll find mugs, cups, plates, bowls, vases, and other bits and pieces in my collection. I use a variety of glaze combinations and playful patterns to decorate my work, and I'm always thinking of new things to make and add to my collection. I just can't stop creating.

Through the enormous support of my family and friends, I've found greater confidence in


exploring the direction of my art. This has also been especially possible through the local and online workshops I've taken since my arrival in the Valley in 2018.

2025 Small Works Exhibition (8"x8")


The exhibition is down now, except for a few paintings still waiting to be collected by their owners.
